

Heart to Heart Communications

Founded by Rev. Norm Douglas, a priest, and Larry Vuillemin, an attorney, this work-life institute helps individuals explore ways to integrate faith and work, to incorporate ethical commitment more fully into everyday decisions, and to bridge the gap between spirituality and daily "busyness".

Their work - life seminars are designed to strengthen ethical decision making, foster better relationships centered in trust, integrity and respect, improve genuine communication, and inspire people to a deeper sense of purpose in their work. Informal monthly gatherings, community forums, retreats, and faith community presentations are held, to help participants make the connection between work and the rest of their lives. There is also an annual breakfast which brings the entire community together to hear a prominent business leader talk about the importance of values in his or her life.

They also have Vocational Reflection Groups which meet regularly to discuss mutual concerns in the workplace. These might be in accord with one's profession, such as education, health care, law enforcement, journalism, and law, among others.

During the past 13 years, over 30,000 people have attended Institute workshops and community programs. The founders have traveled throughout the United States speaking to businesses and faith communities at conferences, seminars and retreats.
